

STAKEHOLDER LETTER Q3 - 2021

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The movement to revolutionize poverty-fighting in Memphis has been validated in its first five years and is rapidly gaining momentum
- Six new poverty-fighting organizations were recently invited to participate in impact studies, bringing the total number of organizations Slingshot works with to 36
- 12 new impact studies were started and another four impact studies were completed
- Slingshot's team has grown to 12 total team members, with four exciting new people joining our team in the past quarter

THE MOVEMENT TO REVOLUTIONIZE POVERTY-FIGHTING IS FIVE YEARS OLD

In late 2016, the movement to revolutionize poverty-fighting in Memphis sparked into existence. Since then, you have helped ignite this movement that continues to gain momentum. Below are some highlights of what we have accomplished together during the movement's first five years.

- 1. **Validated a methodology** that accurately and objectively measures poverty-fighting effectiveness so we can understand and track what is working
- 2. Completed over 50 impact studies, with an additional 17 currently in progress
- 3. **Demonstrated impact studies help empower organizations**, as more than 90% of organizations studied in 2019 have made measurable improvements
- 4. Raised over \$5,000,000 from nearly 850 investors and invested 100% of these funds in the poverty-fighting organizations we work with based on their impact
- 5. **Provided a 90% estimated poverty-fighting return on investment** for the funds raised and invested in 2020 from Slingshot's Impact Accelerator Fund

We have only just started. There is much more we must do together to ensure our movement is fully adopted and increases equitable access to opportunities for all Memphians.

SIX NEW POVERTY-FIGHTING ORGANIZATIONS ADDED

This quarter we transitioned from an annual to a semi-annual process to invite new poverty-fighting organizations to participate in impact studies. These expansion processes will occur in the first and third quarters of the calendar year. Slingshot will expand strategically to help achieve our mission. We will work with organizations from across the poverty-fighting ecosystem to ensure a sufficient breadth of understanding about poverty in Memphis. We will also concentrate in sectors of the poverty-fighting ecosystem that are most relevant in Memphis, enabling us to aggregate insights in the areas that disproportionately influence poverty in the city.

We recently invited six new poverty-fighting organizations to work alongside us, bringing the total number of organizations Slingshot works with to 36. We are excited to work with each of these six new organizations beginning in early 2022.

INSIGHTS FROM RECENT IMPACT STUDIES

In the third quarter we started 12 new impact studies and completed four impact studies. The two organizations that completed updates to their impact studies strongly agreed (highest confidence) that Slingshot accurately and completely measured their organization's poverty-fighting impact and that the opportunities for greater impact Slingshot shared were creative ways to enhance their poverty-fighting impact.

Below is a small sample of the insights from recently completed impact studies:

- Agape Child & Family Services provided 700+ families with devices, internet hotspots, and training at no cost to enable full access to the digital highway
- Economic Opportunities demonstrated Very Strong Systems-Level Change via powerful pathways with parole and probation offices and local employers
- Just City maintained its Very Strong Benefit-Cost Ratio during the pandemic by shifting its focus to the most pressing needs (Community Bail Fund)
- Purdue Center of Hope's Use of Best Practices increased to Very Strong due to new medical roles and robust staff performance management processes

SLINGSHOT'S TEAM CONTINUES TO GROW

Over the past year Slingshot has added seven new team members, with four joining this past quarter. We continue to find people who are not only incredibly talented but also mission-driven and who embody Slingshot's values.
